

MARTIN PETERSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

This scholarship will be awarded to a 2020 graduate of Forsyth High School, Forsyth, Montana. The criteria for this scholarship include a minimum overall GPA of 2.8 (on a scale of 4.0 = A) and active involvement in at least one of the following activities: Speech, Drama, Band or Choir. The scholarship can be used at any 2-year or 4-year college or university in Montana (public or private). The scholarship amount is \$500. Selection will be based primarily on extent of involvement in these activities, with some weight also given to GPA.

The recipient must have attended Forsyth High School for at least 2 high school years. Scholarships will be paid upon proof of successful completion of the first semester/quarter of the student's freshman college year. **Failure to contact the Forsyth Schools Business Office and provide proof of completion of the first quarter/semester by January 31 of the year following award of the scholarship will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.**
