\*The class of 2022 is well below the state percentage for Advanced and Proficient students in ELA. Which means a much larger percentage of students not performing well.

\*There was one more student that moved to Advanced, and the proficiency statistic is comparable to last year, meaning an additional student moved to proficient as well.

\*The class of 2021 has fewer students advanced than the rest of the state in ELA. However, they have more students proficient than the rest of the state and the 7/8 grades.

Proficient	6	20.0%	23.2%	25.9%

\*The Class of 2021 has more students advanced than the state of Montana and fewer at the novice level. However, more students need to move from nearing proficiency to proficient.

\*The Class of 2021 is above the state average in advanced students, 6% below in proficient. While there are fewer students in the Novice category, students need moved from nearing proficiency to proficient.

\*The Class of 2021 has fewer advanced students than the state of Montana, but nearly doubles the proficient level over the state and has about the same amount of novice students.
