Course Overview:

- Create studio projects depicting the 7 Elements of Art
- One written/typed report
- Verbal and written critiques

Grading per Semester:

- Projects 700 points
- Final 50 points

Rules and Expectations:

- Come to class prepared. ALWAYS bring a pencil & eraser.
- BE RESPECTFUL! Respect others, their personal space, and their property.
- Keep your language fit for all ears.
- Do not spit directly into the garbage.
- No throwing objects.
- ALWAYS clean you work area and put supplies away.
