### VISITOR AND SPECTATOR CONDUCT

4315

Any person, including an adult, who behaves in an unsportsmanlike *or inappropriate* manner during *a visit to school or school* ~~an athletic or co-curricular~~ event may be ejected from the event ~~the person is attending~~ and/or denied admission to school events for up to a year, after a Board hearing *permission to access school buildings or property or school events as determined by the Board of Trustees*. Examples of unsportsmanlike conduct include, but are not limited to:

1. Using vulgar or obscene language or gestures;
2. Possessing or being under the influence of any alcoholic beverage or illegal substance;
3. Possessing a weapon;
4. Fighting or otherwise striking or threatening another person;
5. Failing to obey instructions of a security officer or District employee; and
6. Engaging in any activity which is illegal or disruptive.
7. *Other violations of District Policy.*

The Superintendent ~~may seek to deny future admission to any person, by delivering or mailing a notice,~~ *is authorized to temporarily restrict access to school buildings or property and recommend to the Board of Trustees denial of future admission to any person by delivering or mailing a notice* by certified mail with return receipt requested, containing:

1. The date, time and place of a Board hearing;
2. A description of the unsportsmanlike conduct; and
3. The proposed time period admission to school *buildings or property or school* events will be denied.
