GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

**** Amount of scholarship: \$500 – payable at the beginning of the student's 2nd college semester.**

**** The Application Form must be hand-written by the student applying for the scholarship. Applications that are not hand-written by the student applying for the scholarship will not be considered. Hand-written forms must be legible and easy to read for consideration.**

**** All applications must include a 7th semester high school transcript.**

**** Preference may be given to a student who plans to enter the field of education as a career, however is not a requirement.**

**** A minimum GPA of 3.00 (on a 4.00 scale) is required for consideration.**

**** Scholarship can be used: Two (2) year college; Four (4) year college or university; Trade school.**
