PTSA Scholarship Guidelines

MUST BE FILLED OUT BY STUDENT

- 1. PTSA awards one \$500.00 scholarship to high school seniors who plan to attend college or vocational school within 6 months of high school graduation.
- 2. Scholarship committee should consist of at least 3 members appointed by the board.
- 3. Applications must be turned in to high school counselor no later than April 28th.
- 4. All members of scholarship committee will receive copies of applications and transcripts to review at the May PTSA meeting.
- 5. Recipients will be notified of their scholarship in the form of a letter or phone call.
- 6. PTSA will mail the check to the college or vocational school upon receiving a transcript or proof of enrollment.
- 7. Should a recipient not provide proof of enrollment, their scholarship will not be awarded and the \$500.00 will remain in the PTSA general fund.
