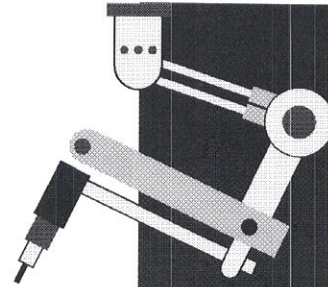

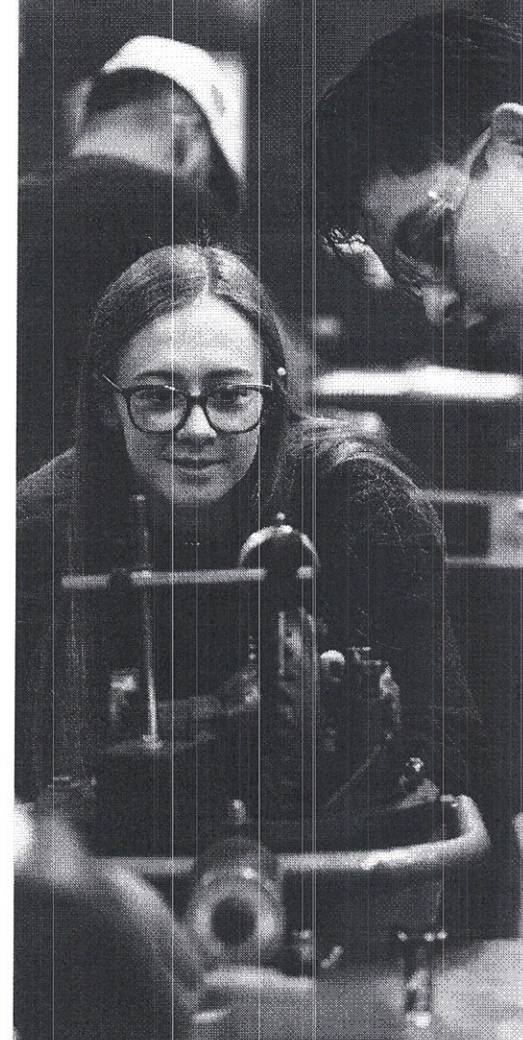

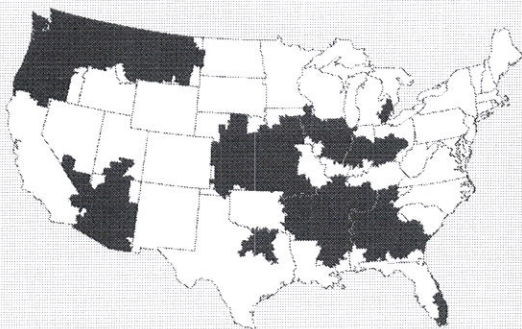

Eligibility

Any individual (high school graduates, career-changing adults, veterans, reskill, etc.) pursuing a degree or certificate in automotive technology (including diesel) in the greater Atlanta, Chicago, Cincinnati, Dallas, Detroit, Kansas City, Miami, Memphis, Phoenix, and Seattle shown on the map.

Who can apply?

- Be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident or approved DACA status
- Be an enrolled future student -or- an active, current automotive or auto/diesel student at a post-secondary Institution in good standing
- Have a completed and approved FAFSA with an EFC under 40000 on file at campus. DACA students will have financial need verified by campus
